

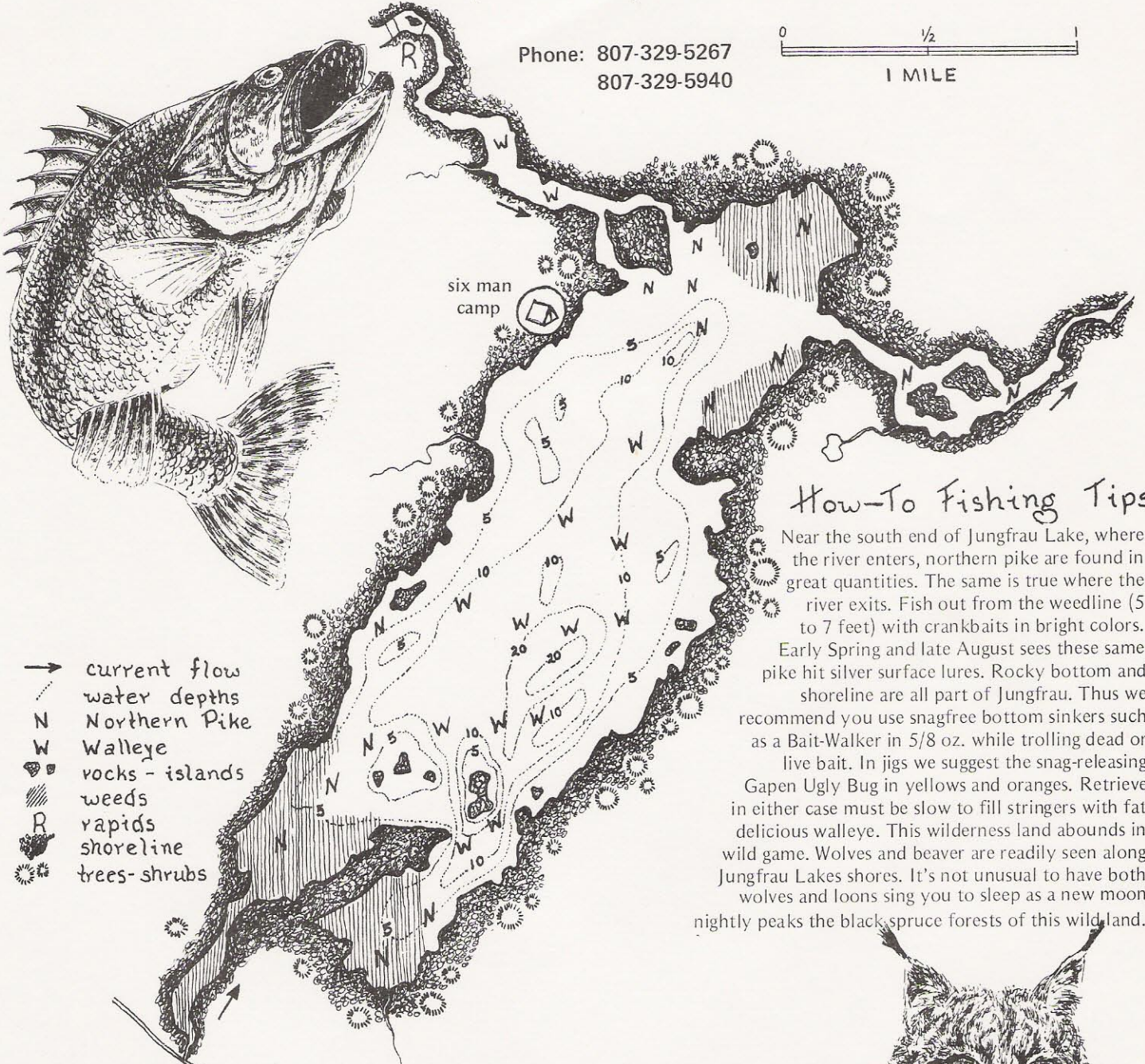
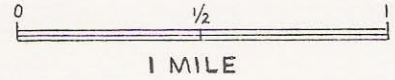

### How-To Fishing Tips:

Near the south end of Jungfrau Lake, where the river enters, northern pike are found in great quantities. The same is true where the river exits. Fish out from the weedline (5 to 7 feet) with crankbaits in bright colors. Early Spring and late August sees these same pike hit silver surface lures. Rocky bottom and shoreline are all part of Jungfrau. Thus we recommend you use snagfree bottom sinkers such as a Bait-Walker in 5/8 oz. while trolling dead or live bait. In jigs we suggest the snag-releasing Gapen Ugly Bug in yellows and oranges. Retrieve in either case must be slow to fill stringers with fat delicious walleye. This wilderness land abounds in wild game. Wolves and beaver are readily seen along Jungfrau Lakes shores. It's not unusual to have both wolves and loons sing you to sleep as a new moon nightly peaks the black spruce forests of this wild land.
